



We hope that by learning Spanish, our students develop a cultural understanding of Spanish speaking countries and become curious about other cultures and traditions. By learning Spanish, students will have a foundation to be able to learn other languages.

Students start learning Spanish in Y7, alongside with another language in Y8 and Y9.

For each unit, students are assessed on at least one skill. Students choose one language for GCSE, many choose two.

We offer Spanish at A-Level and many of our students go on to study Spanish at university.

At A-level students study a range of topics related to the societies from Spanish speaking countries such as festivals and traditions, immigration and racism. Furthermore, students study a Spanish film and read and analyse a Spanish book. They develop essay writing skills, which includes critical analysis.



Nov/Dec Y11 – mock exams in listening, reading, speaking and writing. Each skill is worth 25% of the final grade.
