



We hope that by learning German, our students develop a cultural understanding of German speaking countries and become curious about other cultures and traditions. By learning German, students will lay the foundation to be able to learn other languages.

Students start learning German in Y8, alongside Spanish and continue with two languages until the end for Y9. For each unit, students are assessed on at least one skill.

Students choose one language for GCSE, many choose two.

We offer German at A-Level and many of our A-level students go on to study German at university.

At A-level students study a range of topics related to the societies from German speaking countries such as youth culture, festivals and traditions, immigration and racism.

Furthermore, students study a German film and read and analyse a German book. They develop essay writing skills, which includes critical analysis.



Nov/Dec Y11 – mock exams in listening, reading, speaking and writing. Each skill is worth 25% of the final grade.



Students begin their German learning journey in Y8, having studied Spanish in Y7.
