History Film Club	Students watch Historical films and then carry out debates/activities based on these.

KS4/KS5 Composition Support	A session to work on music coursework with teacher support
Sound Sessions	An opportunity for musicians and those wishing to develop some instrumental/vocal band skills to meet rehearse and collaborate.  Open to years 7-13.
Creative Writing	Yrs 9-11 to work on creative writing skills in a mutually supportive atmosphere. Sessions are every Thursday 3.00pm-4.00pm in B27.
Full Choir	Range of repertoire. Open to all students. Rehearsals on Wednesday at 10.50am in The Recital Hall.
Chamber Choir	Audition entry. Classical Choral repertoire with an expectation to read music or learn quickly.

Training orchestra	Open to students in grade 1-4. Rehearsals take place on Tuesdays from 3-4pm. Strings, wind, brass, percussion instruments welcome.
Strings	Grade 5+ Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass. Rehearsals on Thursday 10.50am in A5.
KS3 textile catch up	After school session to continue textile practical or to extend the techniques students are using in lessons.
Year 11 Food Preparation and Nutrition	Tuesday after school in D60 Opportunities to focus on revision and enhance learning of key concepts
GCSE Art Club	An opportunity for GCSE students to carry on coursework development and have additional conversations regarding their work.
A Level Art Club	An opportunity for A level students to carry on coursework development and have additional conversations regarding their work.
KS3 Netball	Opportunities for students to develop and extend their netball skills. Teams selected to represent the school in regional competitions.
Football	Opportunities for students to develop and extend their football skills. Teams selected to represent the school in regional competitions.
Rugby	Opportunities for students to develop and extend their rugby skills.  Teams selected to represent the school in regional competitions.
Girls Football	Opportunities for students to develop and extend their football skills. Teams selected to represent the school in regional competitions.
Dodgeball	An introduction to a new and fun sport. Great for social interaction.
A Level PE Support	An opportunity for students to extend their knowledge and understanding - one to one teacher support.
GCSE PE Support	An opportunity for students to extend their knowledge and understanding - one to one teacher support.
Hockey	Development of hockey skills in competitive game situations.
Basketball	Development of more advanced Basketball skills in a competitive environment.
Badminton	Coaching provided by a professional coach. At KS3 level - development of a full range of core skills. At KS4 level - advanced tactical development in line with GCSE specifications.
